



## EU RESTRICTS SAUNA CONTROL PLACEMENT - A DESIGN & FUNCTION HEADACHE?

**A** NEW EUROPEAN DIRECTIVE CAME INTO FORCE JANUARY 2009 AND STATES that the sauna control must be placed within 2 metres of the centre of the door (for both commercial and domestic projects).

Where this is not possible a remote control system may be used but must meet with a specified list of conditions in order to comply with the safety standard.

### FULLY COMPLIANT REMOTE CONTROL SYSTEMS

Practically speaking, the new directive causes limitations on function and design. Commercial clients generally require discreet and centrally controlled systems whilst the private client looks to the aesthetic values of any control system.
